Once again all art submitted must incorporate the theme; "The World I love". All winners entries will be printed and framed by us and exhibited in our stores, on our website and our social media pages. The 1<sup>st</sup> prize winner will receive the grand prize of a \$100 Patisserie Florentine voucher. There will be 6 runners up who will receive a PF desert selection box. All winners will be contacted by email and a convenient time arranged to collect their prizes. It is essential the artists fill the consent form below in order to participate.

### How the Competition Works

- The young artist creates an original piece of art based on the theme; "The World I love", the art piece can be in any art style/genre; from impressionist to abstract, and can be inspired by any artist from; Monet or Matisse to Van Gogh or Warhol, but it must be an original piece. The artwork can be a drawing, painting, collage or print, even a combination of mediums but it must be 2D.
